

# **RIT offers Graduate level Supply Chain Certificate**

RIT's College of Engineering has initiated a three course, graduate level, Supply Chain Management Certificate.

Students, who qualify for admission, take two required graduate courses and one elective.

A-Required courses are:

- 1-Supply Chain Management
- 2-Manufacturing Systems Modeling and Performance Analysis

B-Electives include (choose one):

- 1-Systems and Project Management
- 2-Global Facilities Planning
- 3-Management of Quality Systems
- 4-Manufacturing Systems

The takeaways for successful participants include:

- 1-Certificate of Completion from the Kate Gleason College of Engineering
- 2-Twelve graduate level credits fully transferable to the Masters degree in Manufacturing Leadership (MML), the Masters degree in Product Development (MPD) or other appropriate graduate programs at RIT.
- 3-An increased ability to:
  - a-problem solve in the complexities of a global economy
  - b-better achieve competitive advantage for you and your company

It is RIT's intent to deliver these courses in as short a time as possible depending on demand and availability.
